Getting Started with the New Catalog

1. What is the name of the new catalog and how do I get to it?

The catalog is now named Encore. The web address is <http://tdslib.iii.com>

2. How do I log in for the first time?

- You will need to log into the catalog in order to place books on hold, renew items, see what you have checked out, etc.
- You will need to type in your library barcode. Leave the password box blank and click on submit.
(see #1 example below)

3. Why do I need to create a PIN?

After you submit your barcode number, you will be asked to create a PIN. The PIN must be between 6-12 characters long and be a mix of letters and numbers. Click on submit. (see #2 example below)

4. How do I know I'm logged in?

Your name will appear in the upper right hand corner of the screen. Logout is next to your name.

5. What do I do the next time I log in?

You will type your barcode in where it says barcode. Where it says password, type in the PIN you created.

6. What if I forget my PIN/password?

Click on forget your PIN? And enter your barcode number. If you have an e-mail address on record you will receive an e-mail with instructions. If you do not, call your library. The library can help you set up a new PIN, but it cannot tell you what your old PIN was.

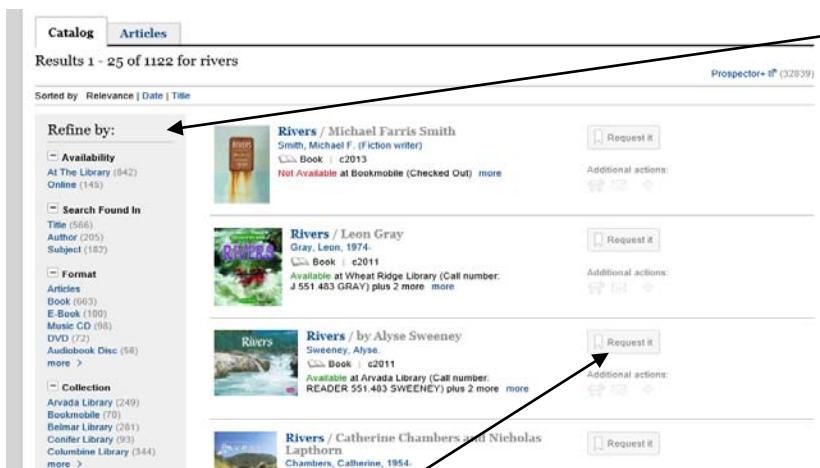
If you would like to place holds, renew items, etc., you must **log in** to your library account, then hit the orange **Home** button to return to the search screen.



Basic Search

Searches title, author and subject fields. Start with a general search. You can refine your search results with the limits listed in the left sidebar.

Refine By: You can further narrow your search by clicking on the choices listed in the left sidebar. Some options include narrowing to location, title, author, format, language, collection, etc.

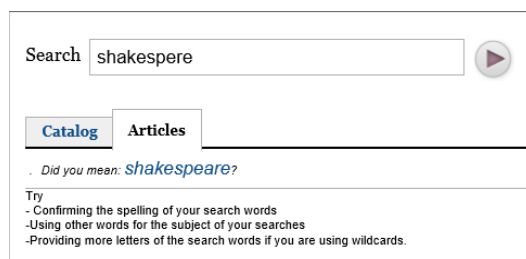
Place a Hold or Request Item: Place holds by clicking the **Request It** button.
